WIZARD And freeze. What do you think Marta will do? Will she let Benjamin move back into her

home? Hmm. Before we find out, let's learn about adverbs. An adverb is word that adds meaning to the verb. The verb is the action word. Adverbs of frequency tell us how often or how many times an action happens. Look at this chart. When we say always, we mean the action happens all the time. Or one hundred percent of the time. Watch

and listen.

**BENJAMIN** I am <u>always</u> careful.

**WIZARD** When we say "often," we mean many times, or 70-80% of the time.

MR. COOK And you often leave early.

**BENJAMIN** Often?

**BOB** Yes. Three times last week.

WIZARD The adverb sometimes means the action or situation happens about half of the time. Or

about fifty percent of the time. Take a look.

**DORA** Sometimes Cornelio is very strange.

WIZARD When we say "seldom", we mean almost never. Or ten to twenty percent of the time.

And when we say "never", we mean zero percent of the time. Listen closely.

BOB Second, you "seldom" do your paperwork right. You never wear one...

### **Adverbs of Frequency**

Adverbs of frequency are words that tell us how often an action occurs. These are words like *never*, *seldom*, *sometimes*, *often and always*. Use the following chart as reference:

Never 0% of the time
Seldom 10-20% of the time
Sometimes 30-50% of the time
Usually 50-60% of the time
Often 60-80% of the time
Always 100% of the time

#### For example:

- Cornelio <u>never</u> rides the bus. We are saying Cornelio does not ride the bus at all.
- They <u>often</u> eat at that restaurant. This means that *they* eat at that restaurant about 60-80% of the time.
- Use the % numbers as a general reference.
